The Greenville County Economic Development Corporation (GCEDC) has undertaken a multimodal transit corridor alternatives feasibility study for a future high capacity transit system between the cities of Greenville, Mauldin, Simpsonville, and Fountain Inn in Greenville County, South Carolina. The focus of the study is a discontinued freight rail line right-of-way corridor of approximately 3 ½ miles long owned by the GCEDC. Various transit and bikeway options are being considered.
